A meeting of the IQAC was held on 29.08.22 at 4:00 PM. in the Conference Room with the Principal, Dr. Subrata Debangana, in chair.

Proceedings of the Meeting

At the outset as per the agenda, Principal Dr. S Debangana gave welcome address .The members, at the beginning, were briefed about the progress after the previous Annual IQAC meeting, the approved proposals which were implemented and which are yet to be implemented. The IQAC Coordinator Dr. Jhansi Jena presented the activities and initiatives of IQAC in the Academic year 2021 - 2022 till date. Discussions were held on the resolutions taken in the previous meeting and a report of actions taken and there outcome was presented in the meeting. As per the decision of previous meeting hard copy of syllabus was distributed among students, Seminar Library set up in all departments, AQAR was Submitted for 5 years from 2016 to 2021 and Submission of IIQA was completed. Payment was done.SSR preparation is pending and it is to be prepared after approval of IIQA. Library automation is under process and college Website has been redesigned. Some proposals has been placed and approved by IQAC like Certificate Courses to be introduced and Enrolment of students in MOOC (SWAYAM) courses will be encouraged, Proposals placed to introduce Spoken English as an Add-on course under financing mode with modest course fees so as to avail the service of quality teachers. The same can be extended to Faculties for honing their English speaking skills .The need for subscription of e-resources, e- payment facilities for students was raised, Infrastructural development, Plan for disable friendly class rooms, Collecting feedback from all the stakeholders are some of the ideas shared by the members. Use of virtual classroom and smart classrooms is to be done extensively and establishment of vermin-composting unit in college campus. A Counselling Cell may be opened by the Department of Psychology to sensitize the students about their mental health and hygiene, about emotional matter which drive them to despair and suicide, family issues and other juvenile matter which they fall a victim to. Women specific sensitive matter may be dealt by Lady faculty members and other issues may be dealt by any member of the department irrespective of gender. As a pilot project as proposed by Dr. Subash chandra Patra the most accomplished department of the College may be asked to initiate the practice of joint teaching -- teaching by two teachers in a particular period in the same class with prior consultation, rehearsal and scripting. They must be cordial and compatible with each other. It can be held once a week and two periods may be devoted for the purpose. If the experience succeeds, other departments can follow suit. Dr. Patra also proposed that As per UGC norm collaborative teaching may be thought of as an innovation. The collaborator here is student. The best student of the Honours class may be asked to act as a teacher for some time with the teacher on duty operating as a facilitator for the assigned time. This will be a sort of teacher training program and also can as a step towards Women Empowerment. This can be thought of as an innovation first and if it proves successful it can be practiced by other departments. All the members took part in the discussion and gave suggestions. Students proposed for Enhancement of number of seats in each subject at least 32 and revival of NCC in college for students.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by Dr. Jyotirmayee Pradhan.
