- PWD AND ELECTRICITY DEPARTMENT to be moved to undertake several repair and renovation work which have become urgent.
- 10. INDUSTRIAL HOUSES OF BALASORE will be requested to allow the science students to visit the indusries to acquire first hand knowledge and experience during their process of learning.
